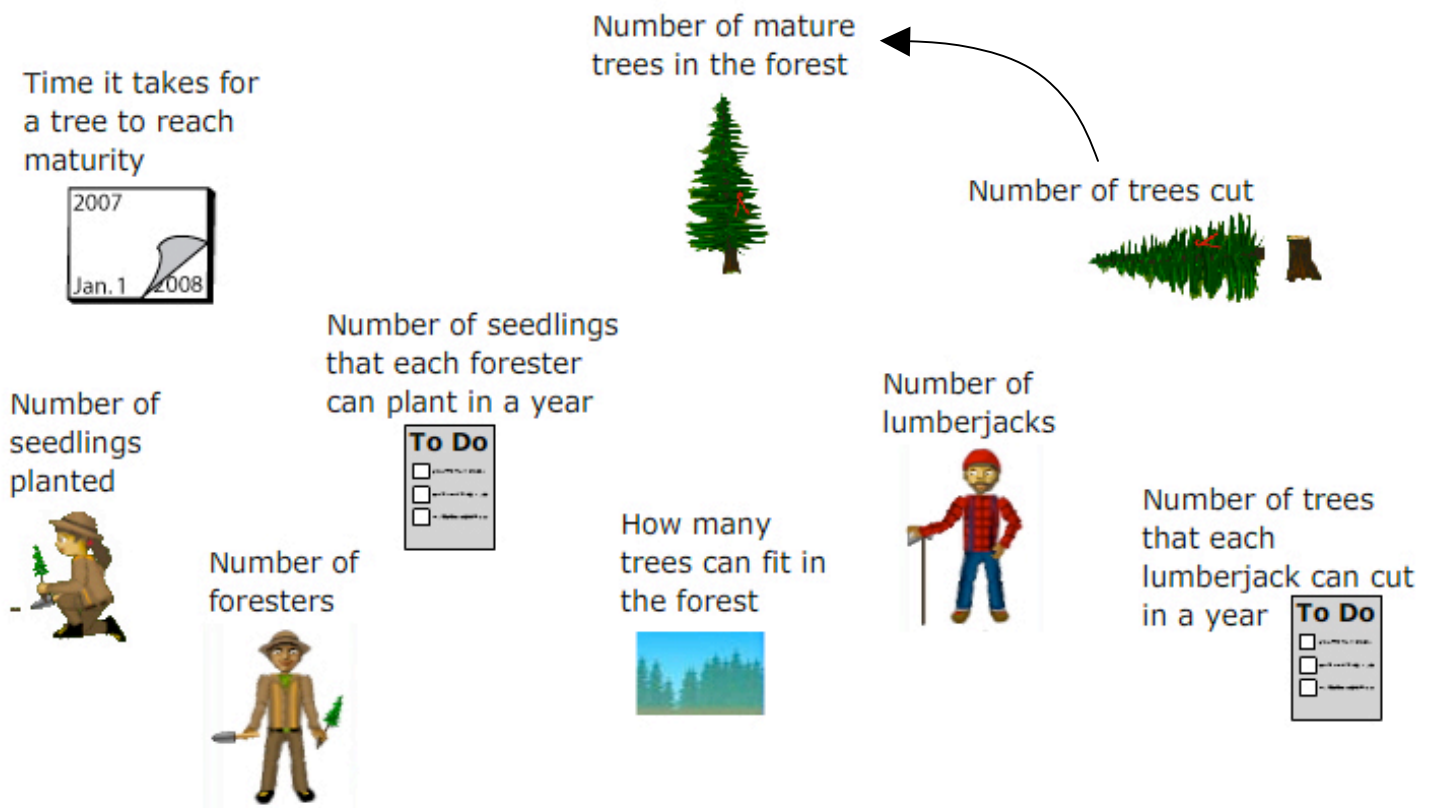


Handout for Forest Animation – Part 1

Take a moment to draw some arrows showing how parts of the simulation affected one another. For example, you might draw an arrow showing a causal relationship between the number of trees cut and the number of mature trees in the forest (see below). This arrow could represent that as trees are cut, less mature trees will be in the forest.
